





Staff Scientist... What?

A staff scientist is a Ph.D. who wants to keep doing bench research in academia but do not want to become a principal investigator.

- Highly-trained, non-tenure researchers focused on research.
- Permanent position (stability)
- Better-paid & benefits
- □ Academic environment (flexibility)
- Mentoring/Teaching opportunities
- ☐ Career development opportunities
- Supportive environment



What does a Staff Scientist do?



The Lab project

Pre-clinical studies for a new cell immunotherapy in organ transplantation



Independent research project

Scientific freedom, highly-risk projects, no pressure, ...



Mentoring junior lab members

Postdocs, technicians



Day to day lab interactions

For many academic researchers, the costs of hiring staff scientists are unsustainable




How do staff scientists fund their independent research projects?
