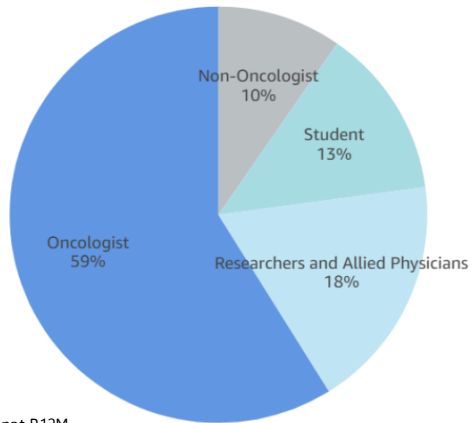

Member Audience Distribution

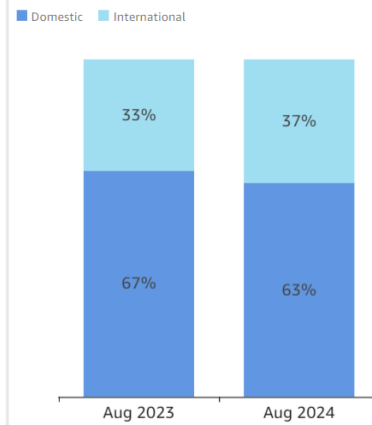

Mix by Oncology Segment

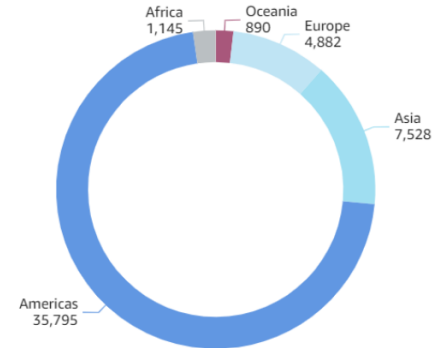


All member count, not R12M
